20th Pizza Hut Pittsburgher Returns September 18-19-20!

The true superspeedway event of dirt is set to take stage on September 18-19-20 as the Pizza Hut "Pittsburgher 100" will roar into action at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway. The UFO Race Championship presented by Comcast Super Late Models will be competing for \$12,000 to win, with championship events for the Semi-Lates, UEMS E-mods, B-Cadets, Sport Stocks & Young Guns. Miley Motor Sports has posted a total payoff in all divisions of over \$80,000.

The Pizza Hut "Pittsburgher 100" will kick off on Thursday Night, September 18 with an open practice for all divisions. Gates will open on Thursday at 4:30 with practice scheduled to start approximately 6:00 PM. Friday Night, September 19 will feature the qualifier races for the UFO Super Late Models, as well as heat races for all other divisions. Gates open on Thursday will also open at 4:30 with warm ups at 6:00 and racing set to start at 7:00 PM.

Saturday, September 20 will mark the return of the 100-lap feature for Pizza Hut "Pittsburgher 100". In superspeedway style, the event will feature a 32 car starting grid on the monster 1/2 mile track for the national championship event. The UFO Super Late Model winner will take home \$12,000. UFO Super Late Model B-Features as well as championship features and consolations for all other divisions will round out the racing program. The Semi-Lates, E-mods and B-Cadets will compete for \$1,000 to win with an additional \$250 in lap money posted for the Semi-Lates from Rohrich Parts Warehouse. The Sport Stocks & Young Guns will compete for \$100 to win. Gates will open at 1:00 with racing starting at 7:00 PM. The rain date for the race is Sunday, September 21.

The quest for the UFO Race Championship Tour presented by Comcast is at an absolute tie going into the Pizza Hut "Pittsburgher 100". Lernerville Super Late Model back-to-back Champion Alex Ferree and PPMS Super Late Model back-to-back champion Jared Miley finished one spot apart at the last UFO Race Championship event closing the previous 1 point gap to zero. Keith Barbara and Gregg Satterlee hover just 21 and 30 points behind the leaders with Shawn McGarvey following at 58.5 points behind the leaders.

Previous "Pittsburgher 200 winners include Scott Bloomquist, Bob Wearing, Jr., Donnie Moran, Davey Johnson, Tim Hitt, Rick Aukland, Todd Andrews, Chub Frank, Matt Urban, Shane Clanton and Bart Hartman. Clint Smith was the most recent race winner in 2007

UFO car rules and race format will be used for the Super Late Model program, which will include the PPMS "lucky dog" rule where lapped cars will receive one lap back on each caution period. PPMS special event rules will be in effect for the Semi-Lates, B-Cadets and Sport Stocks. These rules make virtually all cars that compete at area tracks in these divisions legal to compete with weight and spoiler variances for different motor types. UEMS car rules will apply for the E-mods, while PPMS rules will apply for the Young Guns. Race teams are reminded that the pre-entry cut off is this Friday, September 12. Entries postmarked by that date will receive a 33% discount. The entry form is available on the Pittsburgher page at the track website. Super Late Model pre-entry is \$100 with gate entry at \$150. Semi-Late, E-mod and B-Cadet pre-entry is \$50 with a \$75 gate entry.

Discount advance tickets can also be purchased by contacting the track office at 412-279-7223 through Friday, September 12. Advance two day tickets for Friday and Saturday are \$38 for adults and seniors, \$25 for juniors 13-16, \$15 for children 7-12 and \$50 for the pits. Two day Friday-Saturday tickets at the gate will be \$40 for adults, \$39 for seniors, \$28 for juniors 12-16, \$17 for children 7-12 and \$55 for the pits. Admission for Thursday will be \$17 for the pits with free grandstand admission. One day tickets for Friday will be \$20 for adults, \$19 for seniors, \$10 for juniors 13-16, \$10 for children 7-12 and \$27 for the pits. Tickets for Saturday will be \$40 for adults, \$39 for seniors, \$28 for juniors 12-16, \$17 for children 7-12 and \$55 for the pits.

Free camping is available for 2008 with reserved spots also available for \$50 by contacting the speedway office. All campers must register with the speedway regardless if the camping is free or reserved according to township ordinances. The camping registration form may also be found at the track website.

The UFo Race Championship presented by Comcast has over \$400,000 of prize payoffs and contingencies for Super Late Model teams over the scheduled races including a points bonus for the top 10 drivers at the end of the season. The points bonus includes \$1,000 for each completed event plus 100% of additional sponsor contributions. The tour has \$40,000 of contingency awards available to drivers through the Contingency Connection Program. The Pass Maximum award winner from the feature event plus the top 2 drivers in UFo points that do not qualify for the feature will be awarded contingency prize bundles at the events.
