## **UFO at Roaring Knob Rescheduled for Aug 1, Next Race July 18 at PPMS**

Due to incoming severe storms, the UFO "Mega-Blitz 2009" at Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex has been cancelled and Rescheduled for Saturday, August 1. With the new date at Roaring Knob, the UFO Race Championship tour will be in action the next 4 weekends.

The next event will be the 3rd "Red Miley 53" at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway on Saturday night July 18. The UFO Super Late Models will compete in a 53-lap championship feature with a total of \$8,109 to win. The feature winner will receive \$5,300 and \$53 will be paid to the leader of each lap. This event will carry an open brand tire rule, and will awarded UMP DIRTcar points. The DIRTcar Pro-Lates, E-mods and Sportsman will compete for bonus money with the Factory Stocks and Young Guns completing the program.

Previous winners of the "Red Miley 53" include Steve Baker and Josh Richards. Gates will open at 5:00 with warm-ups at 6:00 and racing at 7:00 PM. Adult grandstand admission is \$20, seniors \$19, junior 13-16 \$15, children 7-12 \$5 and pits \$32.

Payout for the UFO Super Late Models for the 53-lap "Red Miley 53" is 1st - \$5,300 2nd -\$2,000 3rd -\$1,400 4th -\$1,200 5th -\$1,000 6th -\$800 7th -\$700 8th -\$600 9th -\$550 10th -\$500 11th -\$475 12th -\$450 13th -\$440 14th -\$425 15th - \$400 16th -\$390 17th -\$375 18th -\$375 19th -\$375 20th -\$375 21st -\$350 22nd -\$350 23rd -\$350 24th -\$350. The leader of each lap will be paid \$53. \$100 tow money for any car that races and does not qualify for the feature. This event will have no Super Late Model car entry fee. All drivers at PPMS are required to use RACEceiver 1 way radios.

The UFO Super Late Models will be paired with the BRP Big Block Modifieds for an all-out assault from the North for the "WV/PA Border State Bullring Battle" at Tyler County Speedway on Saturday Night July 25. The Area-51 lap Super Late Model feature will pay \$4,000 to win along the only WV appearance in 2009 of the Big Block Modifieds. Other Tyler County divisions will also be in action on the bullring ¼ mile.

Tim Dohm of Cross Lanes, WV captured the 2008 UFO Race Championship feature at Tyler and Brian Swartzlander won the 2008 Big Block Modified event at Tyler from the 23rd position. Gates will open at 4:00, warm-ups at 6:30 and racing at 7:00 PM. Admission prices will be released soon.

Payout for the UFO Super Late Models for the Area 51-lap "WV/PA Border State Bullring Battle" is 1st - \$4,000 2nd -\$1,800 3rd -\$1,200 4th -\$1,000 5th -\$800 6th -\$700 7th -\$600 8th -\$550 9th -\$500 10th -\$450 11th -\$425 12th -\$400 13th -\$390 14th -\$375 15th -\$350 16th -\$340 17th -\$325 18th -\$325 19th -\$325 20th -\$325 21st -\$300 22nd -\$300 23rd -\$300 24th -\$300. \$100 tow money for any car that races and does not qualify for the feature. This event will also have no Super Late Model car entry fee.

The "Mega Blitz 2009" presented by Commonwealth Marketing Group at the Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex is now scheduled for Saturday night, August 1. The event will pay \$3,000 to the winner of the Mach-41 lap feature. "Mega-Blitz" was Challenger Raceway's traditional mid-summer event and will now move to Roaring Knob.

Fastrak Late Models, E-mods, Street Stocks and Chargers will complete the racing program. Jeremy Miller of Gettysburg, PA won the initial appearance of the UFO Race Championship at Roaring Knob in 2008. Previous "Mega-Blitz" winners include Davey Johnson, Keith Barbara, Robbie Blair and Billy Drake. Roaring Knob has had strong Super Late Model car counts in 2009 for their regular events, and a great field of drivers is expected for the "Mega-Blitz."

This event will also be the 3rd of the 3 race "King of the Knob" qualifier races, which will determine the track provisional for the UFO "King of the Knob" in September. Pit Gates will open at 4:30, grandstands at 5:00, warm-ups at 6:15 and racing at 7:00 PM. Grandstand admission is \$15, with children 10 & under free. Pit admission is \$25. RACEceiver 1 way radios are required at Roaring Knob.

The following weekend will see two UFO Race Championship events. The UFO Super Late Models will make their debut at the Lernerville Speedway on Friday Night, August 7 for the "Lunarville 33." The 33-lap championship will pay \$2,000 to the winner. This event will also be DIRTCAR/UFO Fan Nite, as regular Lernerville grandstand admission prices will be in effect. The DIRTCAR Sprints, Big Block Modifieds and Sportsman will complete the program at Lernerville.

Payout for the UFO Super Late Models for the 33-lap "Lunarville 33" is 1st - \$2,000 2nd -\$1,000 3rd -\$800 4th -\$700 5th - \$600 6th -\$550 7th -\$500 8th -\$450 9th -\$400 10th -\$350 11th -\$325 12th -\$300 13th - \$290 14th -\$275 15th -\$250 16th -\$240 17th -\$200 18th -\$200 19th -\$200 20th -\$200 21st -\$200 22nd - \$200 23rd -\$200 24th -\$200. \$100 tow money for any car that races and does not qualify for the feature. The "Lunarville 33" will have no Super Late Model race entry fee. RACEceiver 1 way radios are required at Lernerville.

The following night, Saturday, August 8 the UFO Super Late Models will return to Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway for the "F-2 Shockwave." This event will award points for the UFO Race Championship, the United Late Model Series and DIRTCAR/UMP. "The Shockwave" will feature the exciting UFO twin features format, with two 31-lap features paying a total of \$5,000 to win. The DIRTCAR Pro-Lates, E-mods, Sportsman, Factory Stocks & Young Guns will complete the program.

Spec motor cars will use "Option 1" rules with a 2,200 pound weight limit, 12" rear spoiler and 4" nose spillboard at all events except PPMS. At PPMS, "Option 2" rules will be in effect with 2,250 pound weight limit, 12" rear spoiler and no spillboard. Open motor cars will weight 2,250 pounds at all events with an 8" spoiler. All UFO Race Championship events run under an open-brand tire rule.
