Elkins Speedway and UFO Race Championship Join Forces for \$32,000 RH Armstrong Memorial!

UFO sightings will take place in the mountains of West Virginia on August 8 as Elkins Speedway and the UFO Race Championship will join forces for the "RH Armstrong Memorial." This traditional WV racing event will feature an amazing total payoff of over \$32,000 for the UFO Super Late Models.

The Elkins Speedway has experienced a new surge of energy in 2009 under the new management of WV Motorsports Promotions headed by A.J. Rockwell. The facility has received major improvements including an improved racing surface and new hillside seating. Increased driver payoffs across the season have resulted in strong car counts and massive crowds. The speedway is a fan-favorite as it features a huge hillside that accommodates lawn chair seating, and has acres of free camping.

The "RH Armstrong Memorial" will mark the first-ever appearance of the UFO Race Championship at the 3/8 mile track. The racing program will be highlighted by the \$6,000 to win, \$500 to start Area 51-lap UFO Super Late Model feature event.

Race fans will be treated to a double late model invasion as the FASTRAK Late Model Regional Tour will also be in competition. The FASTRAK Late Models will compete in a \$1,500 to win championship event. All Elkins Speedway classes will be in competition that night. Since FASTRAK is a crate-only touring series, any of the track's steel block Semi-Lates are welcome to compete with the UFO Super Late Models for this event.

While the "RH Armstrong Memorial" features a mammoth payoff, it also features a tiny grandstand ticket price. With the sponsorship of Rick Sturms Motorsports, grandstand admission will only be \$15. Pit tickets will be \$35. Pit gates will open at 4:00, grandstand gates at 5:00, warmups at 7:00 and racing at 7:30 PM.

UFO Super Late Model rules will be in effect for this event. Open motor cars will weigh 2,250 pounds and use an 8" spoiler. Spec motor cars will use the Option 1 rules and weigh 2,200 pounds, use a 12" spoiler and be permitted a 4" nose spillboard. The UFO Race Championship competes under an open brand tire rule.

Payout for the UFO Super Late Models for the 51-lap "RH Armstrong Memorial" is 1st - \$6,000 2nd - \$4,000 3rd - \$3,500 4th - \$3,000 5th - \$2,500 6th - \$2,000 7th - \$1,500 8th - \$1,000 9th - \$750 10th - \$500 11th - \$500 12th - \$500 13th - \$500 14th - \$500 15th - \$500 16th - \$500 17th - \$500 18th - \$500 19th - \$500 20th - \$500 21st - \$500 22nd - \$500 23rd - \$500 24th - \$500. \$100 tow money for any car that races and does not qualify for the feature. With the feature payoff being in excess of \$10,000 over the UFO base payoff, a \$50 entry fee will apply for this event. All drivers at Elkins are required to use RACEceiver 1 way radios.

To accommodate the "RH Armstrong Memorial", Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway will now present the "F-2 Shockwave" on Saturday Night, August 15. The twin 31-lap feature program will pay a total of \$5,000 to win for the UFO Super Late Models in a triple sanctioned program that will include the United Late Model Series and award UMP DIRTcar points.

The next UFO Race Championship event is the "WV/PA Border State Bullring Battle," this Saturday, July 25 at the Tyler County Speedway. The UFO Super Late Models will compete in an Area 51-lap feature paying \$4,000 to win with the BRP Big Block Modifieds competing in a \$3,000 to win, 40-lap companion event. The tour will make its first appearance of the year at the Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex on Saturday August 1 with the \$3,000 to win, "Mega-Blitz 2009." On August 7, the night preceding the Elkins event, the UFO Super Late Models will be at the Lernerville Speedway for the "Lunarville 33."
