The UFO F-2 Shockwave Will Shake The Earth Twice on Saturday August 15 at PPMS!

(Mars, PA) - After completing four thrilling events over the last two weekends, the UFO Race Championship will continue its flight with one of its most exciting events of summer. The "F-2 Shockwave" will pay a total of \$5,000 to win for Super Late Models at Pittsburgh's Pennsylvania Motor Speedway on Saturday Night August 15. The "F-2 Shockwave" will be co-sanctioned by the United Late Model Series and will offer DIRTcar points.

The UFO / ULMS Super Late Models will compete in the unique twin feature format. Each 31-lap feature will pay \$2,500 to the winner, for a total of \$5,000 to win.
