### Elkins Announces 2010 UFO Dates!

(Mars, PA)--Looking ahead to the 2010 racing season, Elkins Speedway promoter A.J. Rockwell announces the dates of a few bigger shows at the Kerens, WV dirt oval as well as a few format changes during race competition.

"We wanted to get the word out early on the Chuck Gear Memorial and the R.H. Armstrong Memorial for next season", stated Rockwell. "Race fans let us know how well they liked the race format for the Armstrong Memorial and we are very happy to announce that both the R.H. Armstrong Memorial as well as the Chuck Gear Memorial will be UFO Sanctioned. We received a lot of email and phone calls about how well the races were...usually we only get that much response if something went wrong!", joked Rockwell. "From what we seen, no time trials and double-file restarts helped promote a multi-groove racing surface that enabled the guys who were fast enough to pass and passing is what the fans pay to see." he continued.

The dates for Elkins Speedways' two biggest shows of the season are as follows:

Saturday, June 19, 2010--UFO Sanctioned "Chuck Gear Memorial"--\$5,000 to win!

Saturday, Aug. 7, 2010--UFO Sanctioned "R.H. Armstrong Memorial"—at least \$5,000 to win!

"We had several regional racers who expressed a lot of interest in racing with us last year for the Chuck Gear race but scheduling conflicts with another big show put them in a tough situation...this year we will break away from our traditional Gear date and move it back one week (to Sat. June 19) to let those drivers compete. We really feel like doing this is in both the race teams and fans best interest, especially the fans who want to catch both races." said Elkins Speedway spokesman Jimmy Henry

Also, look for a major race format change as well for the 2010 season. It has been decided that all features in all classes will be a double-file restart format to help produce a wider racing groove as well as provide fans with a little more excitement.

"Here at Elkins Speedway, we are competing with a lot of entertainment choices. The general public has a lot of options to keep them entertained...anything from reality TV, to WWE, to Saturday night NASCAR shows to whatever. We feel like we have to keep them coming back for more and if we don't, we probably won't see them again. We have to remember we are not the only game in town," said promoter Rockwell.
