UFO Race Championship Announces 2008 Contingency Connection Program!

The UFO Race Championship Tour presented by Comcast has come to an agreement to participate in the Contingency Connection program. This program will allow up to \$50,000 of contingency awards to be available to Super Late Model drivers competing on the tour.

During the 2008 season, 50 contingency winners will be determined. The initial winners will include the Pass Maximum Award (the driver that advances the most positions in the feature event) and the top 2 drivers in point standings that do not qualify for the feature at specified events. The top 2 non-qualifiers from the consolation will receive the award at the initial event. The top 10 drivers in the season-ending point standings will also be included in the 50 contingency winners, with the remaining winners to be determined based on the number of events after the 2008 schedule is finalized.

Contingencies will be awarded based on drivers displaying the product sticker on their car and/or use of certain products. Drivers will register once for the season to participate in the UFO Contingency Connection program and will indicate which contingencies they are eligible for at that time. Winners will be reported by UFO officials to the Contingency Connection throughout the season. The Contingency Connection will send winner reports to the manufacturers monthly beginning June 15, and these winners will be sent \$25 product certificates or \$25 product packages directly from the manufacturers toward product purchase for each contingency for which they are eligible. No limit has been placed on the number of times a driver can win the contingency awards.

The Contingency Connection is in the process of finalizing sponsor contracts and will have the full list of sponsors at the beginning of April. National manufacturers such as JE Pistons, Auto Meter, MSD, Comp Cams, Mr. Gasket, Hedman Heddors, Richmond Gear, TCI, ACCEL, Lincoln Electric, Taylor Vertex, Melling, Zoom Clutches, RJS Safety Equipment and many more are participating in the program. The addition of the Contingency Connection program to the UFO Race Championship presented by Comcast is yet another strong step forward that the tour has made for regional racers since its inception 3 months ago. The UFO Race Championship presented by Comcast is an exciting new concept which aligns western Pennsylvania clay-surface speedways with unified rules and procedures. Over \$334,000 in payoffs are available in 2008 including the year-end, point bonus. Interest of race teams is running extremely high, as the UFO Race Championship is providing a cost-effective alternative for the race teams to compete in high-profile, high paying events with minimal travel.

The highly anticipated debut of the UFO Race Championship will take place on Sunday, April 13 with the first-ever PA State Short Track Championships event at the Challenger Raceway. The Super Late Model "Area-51"-lap feature will pay \$5,000 to the winner with UFO rules Semi-Lates, E-mod Sportsman & Roadrunners also on the racing card for championship races. The 2nd event is scheduled at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway on Sunday night May 13 with the F-2 Shockwave twin 30's paying \$5,000 total to win. UFO rules Semi-Lates, E-mod Sportsman & Cadets will compete for increased payoffs on that night along with the PPMS Amateur Stocks and Young Guns. Tyler County Speedway recently joined the UFO Race Championship and will hold their event in August.

Additionally, weekly racing is scheduled to open at both Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway and Tyler County on Saturday, April 5. PPMS features Super Late Models, Crate Late Models, E-mods, Pure Stocks, Amateur Stocks and Young Guns while Tyler County features Super Late Models, (crate) Semi-Lates, E-mods, Pure Stocks, Modified Lites, Junkyard Warriors and Mini-Wedges. Challenger will hold their 2008 Blastoff on Saturday, April 12 with a \$2,000 to win Super Late Model championship plus UFO rules Cadet and Sport Stock championships.
