John Mollick Mega-Blitzes Roaring Knob field in UFO Race Championship!

MARS, PA (August 1, 2009) John Mollick from Toronto, Ohio earned the \$3,000 first place money in Mega-Blitz 2009 on Saturday night in the Unified Force Race Championship event at Roaring Knob Motorsports Complex in Markleysburg, PA. Taking the lead on a lap 28 restart, Mollick controlled the remaining distance in the 41-lap event in his first Super Late Model start at Roaring Knob.

"We had the engine out of the car early in the week. We got it back together and here we are," said Mollick, who moved in to the UFO Series point lead with his victory in his L&R Racing/Ridge Machine CC Performance Ford powered Rocket.

Five qualifying heats were run for the 40-car field. Bob Gordon took the win in Heat 1 from the pole position. Chuck Harper won Heat 2, after swapping the lead with Steve Everhart. Keith Jackson was the winner of Heat 3, from second starting position. John Mollick won Heat 4 from second spot, with Butch McGill winning Heat 5 also from second. Two B-Mains rounded out the field, won by Chad McClellan and Andy Anderson.

The top two drivers from each heat race drew for the top ten starting positions. Keith Jackson and Gary Dalton drew front row starting spots, and Jackson powered to the lead at the drop of the green for the 41-lap main event. Dalton and Gregg Satterlee battled for second in the early laps, with Butch McGill and Steve Everhart filling the top five. The first caution appeared on lap 7. McGill gained a spot on the restart to third, before the yellow flew again on lap 8. McGill advanced to second on the next restart, as the yellow appeared again on lap 10.

Jackson again set the pace when racing resumed over McGill, Dalton, Everhart, and Satterlee. Eventual winner Mollick was sixth at this point, and 22nd starting Andy Anderson had charged through the field into the top ten, in ninth position. Everhart and Satterlee got by Dalton by lap 13, as the yellow appeared again with 15 laps in.

Back to green, lap 16 saw Jackson leading McGill, with Satterlee, Everhart, and a charging Chuck Harper now fifth after starting tenth. Harper moved to fourth a lap later, and at the halfway mark on lap 21 passed Satterlee for third as his car started smoking at this point. When the next caution came out at lap 23, Harper retired from the event.

When racing resumed, it was Jackson still leading McGill, with ninth starting John Flinner now third, Satterlee fourth, and Mollick in fifth. On lap 28, while racing for second, Flinner got into the turn four outside wall to bring out the caution for a what would be an eventful restart.

On the double file restart, the two front row cars drag raced for the lead as the green flag waved. As McGill nosed ahead, the two cars made contact with McGill spinning to set off a melee on the front stretch. Both drivers were eventually disqualified for their actions under the caution period.

The new running order would have Satterlee the new leader over Mollick, Anderson, Dalton, and Everhart. With this being the final restart of the event, Mollick used the outside to take the lead, one the new Series point leader would hold for the remaining distance for his first UFO Race Championship victory. Dalton took second on lap 30, and remained there to the finish in his Appalachian Timber Products, Wilson Works sponsored Cornett powered Rocket Chassis. Anderson earned third place money in his impressive run from 22nd, in his Carquest Auto Parts, ARC, Leggett Engine Research Ford powered Rocket, giving Ford two of the top three finishing spots. Satterlee was fourth in his Satterlee Petroleum Distributors/East American Motorsports Custom powered Rocket. Fifth was Everhart in his Imler Poultry, Ritchey Well Drilling Hershey powered Rocket. Tim Senic, Jared Miley, Billy Holbert, defending Series champion Alex Ferree, and Chad McClellan rounded out the top ten.

The UFO Championship Tour is quickly back into action on Sunday, August 2, with the running of the Earl Hill Championship at Tyler County Speedway in Middlebourne, WV. The winner of the 41-lap main event will earn \$3,000. Race time is 7:00.
